Plant type Medium Canopy Tree
Potential Size Height 50-70 ft.
Spread 50-75 ft.
Rate of Growth Very Fast
Wetland Indicator Status Facultative

Site Conditions plant prefers or can tolerate.

Soil Drainage Ranges from poor to excessive
Soil Texture Moderately coarse to fine
