Plants similar by type, wetland status and light preference for Mid-Atlantic Forest Associations.

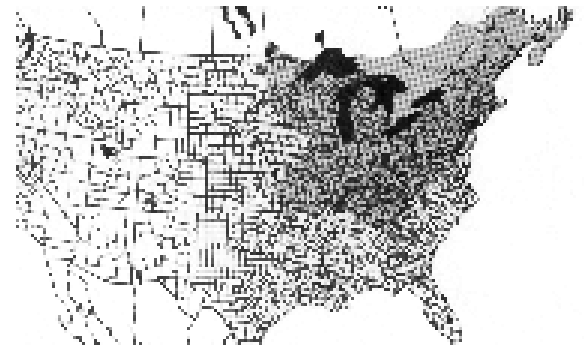
White oak, American beech
