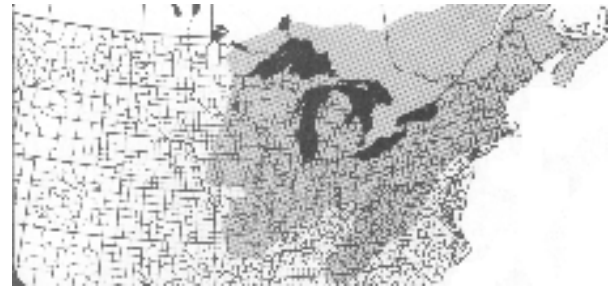


Amelanchier laevis Alleghany Serviceberry
