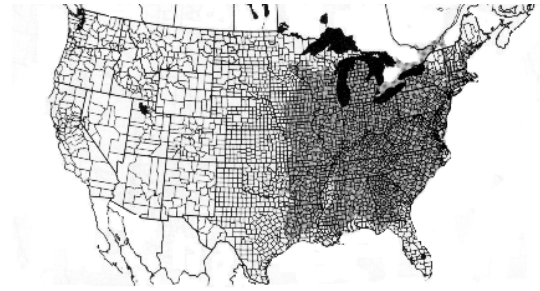


Quercus alba White Oak

Plant type Large Canopy Tree
Potential Size Height 80-100 ft.
Spread 50-80 ft
Rate of Growth Slow
Wetland Indicator Status Facultative Upland

Site Conditions plant prefers or can tolerate.

Soil Moisture	Average to Dry
Soil Drainage	Moderately well to Excessive
Soil Texture	Coarse to Fine
Light Preference	Full sun to Partial shade
