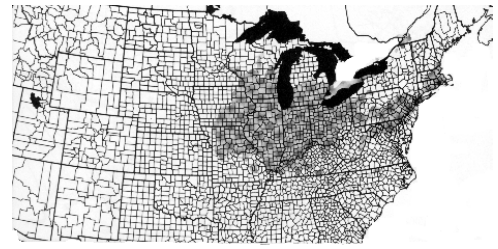


## Quercus bicolor

## Swamp White Oak

<b>Plant type</b>	Large Canopy Tree
<b>Potential Size</b>	Height 75-100 ft. Spread 50-75 ft.
<b>Rate of Growth</b>	Medium to Fast
<b>Wetland Indicator Status</b>	Facultative Wetland

### Site Conditions plant prefers or can tolerate.

Soil Moisture	Saturated to Average
Soil Drainage	Moderately poor to Very poor
Soil Texture	Medium to Coarse
Light Preference	Full sun to Partial shade
