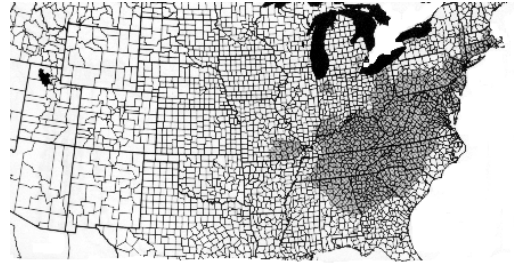


Quercus coccinea Scarlet Oak

Plant type Large Canopy Tree
Potential Size Height 50-75 ft.
 Spread 40-50 ft.
Rate of Growth Medium to Fast
Wetland Indicator Status Facultative Upland



Site Conditions plant prefers or can tolerate.
