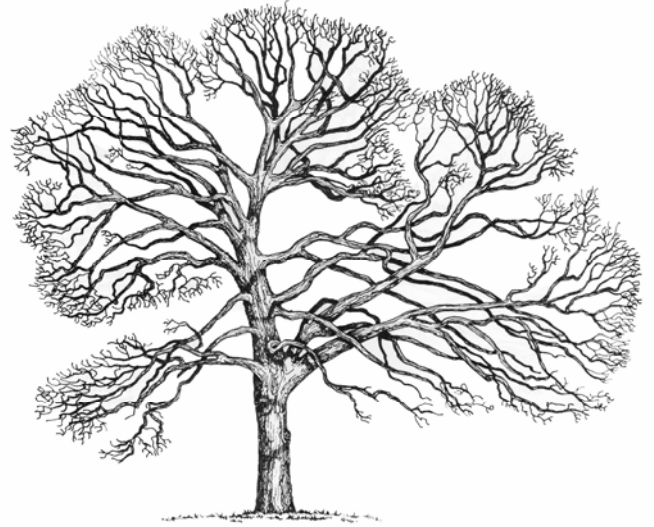
Plant type Large Canopy Tree

Rate of Growth Slow
Wetland Indicator Status Facultative

 Soil Drainage Moderately poor to well
 Soil Texture Coarse to fine
 Light Preference Full sun

Plants similar by type, wetland status and light preference for Mid-Atlantic Forest Associations.

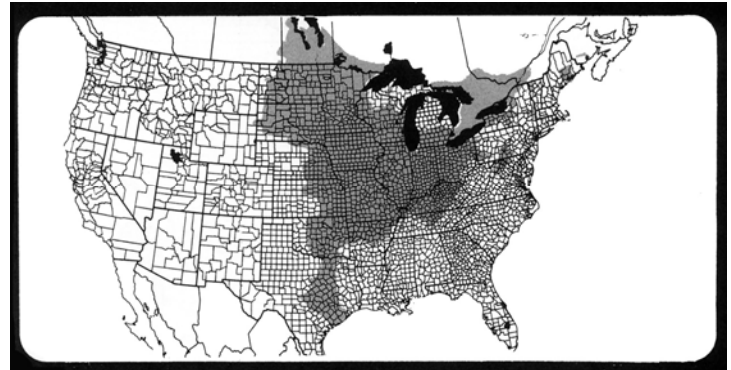
White, Black, and Swamp White Oaks, American Elm, Hackberry
