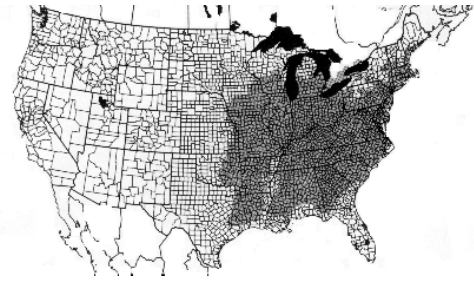


Quercus velutina Black Oak
