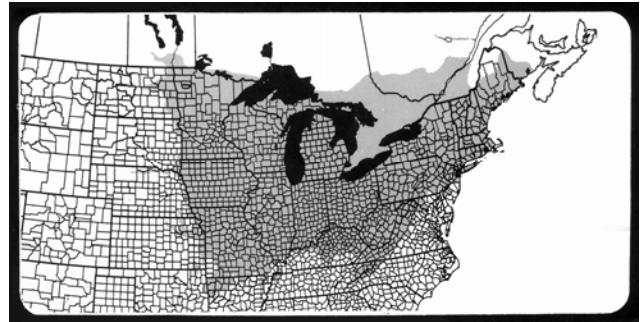
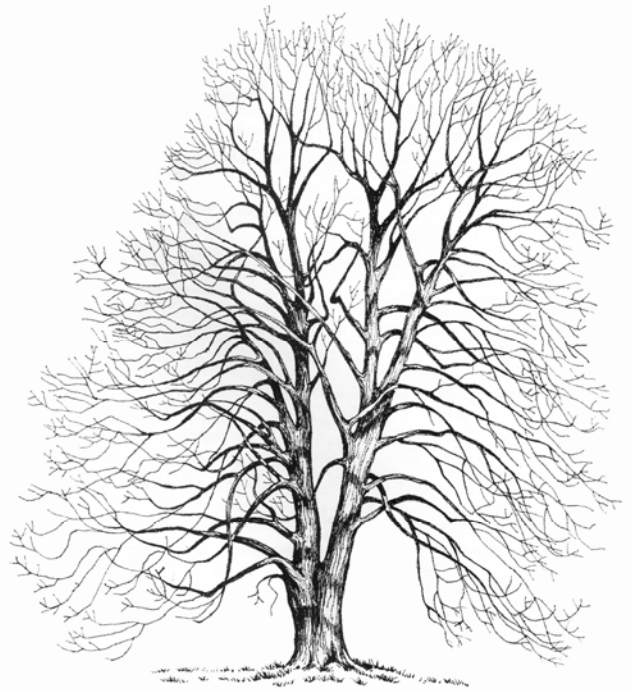
Plants similar by type, wetland status and light preference for Mid-Atlantic Forest Associations.
