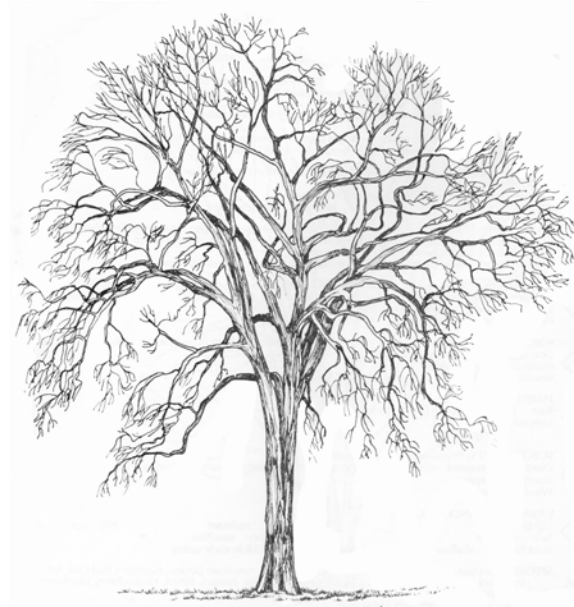
Plant type Large Canopy Tree

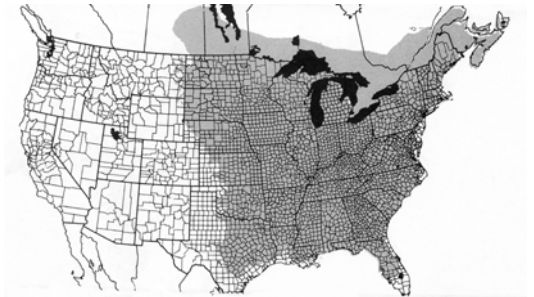
